The Secretary, Judicial Service Commission would like to inform the candidates shortlisted for Oral Interviews and members of the general public as follows:

1. After further consultation of the stakeholders, the earlier Interview schedule previously displayed on the JSC Website (<https://www.jsc.go.ug>) has been revised. The Schedule is specifically for the following positions:
